

- The submitter is concerned that there is not enough flexibility in Proposed Policies 12 and 15 to allow for minor adjustments of the urban boundary other than in association with the identified Greenfields Outline Development Plan areas.

I seek the following decision from the local authority:

(give precise details)

Either:

- The inclusion of a new clause in Policy 12 to enable small adjustment to the urban boundary where a permanent limit to urban expansion has been provided by the transfer of land permanently into public open space leaving an isolated pocket of rurally zoned land.
- The inclusion of a further bullet point to Policy 15(d) to explain that a small adjustment may be appropriate in the circumstances outlined above.


Or:

- Where such transfer of land into public ownership has occurred (such as on Montgomery Spur or Clifton Hill) that the urban boundary shown on Map 1 be adjusted accordingly.
