SUBJECT: Clause 16(2) changes to the decisions version of Plan Change 4 to the

Canterbury Land and Water Regional Plan.

The following corrections are to be made to the decisions version of Plan Change 4 to the Canterbury Land & Water Regional Plan pursuant to Clause 16(2) of Schedule 1 to the Resource Management Act 1991 (RMA).

Clause 16(2) of Schedule 1 states:

"A local authority may make an amendment, without using the process in this schedule, to its proposed policy statement or plan to alter any information, where such an alteration is of minor effect, or may correct any minor errors"

The following table identifies the errors in the decisions version of Plan Change 4 to the Canterbury Land and Water Regional Plan and the corrections to be made.
