Safety conditions:

- 1. This exemption only applies on the designated days of the Real Swim Series, between the hours of 1600 and 2100.
- 2. There is only to be one authorised safety vessel in the exempted area per event.
- 3. The vessel is to be an approved rescue boat such as used by Surf life Saving New Zealand which is an inflatable with protected propeller.
- 4. The vessel is to be operated with a minimum of two crew members, both who are to be trained and qualified as rescue crew.
- 5. The vessel is to operate at less than 5 knots except in the case of an emergency.
- 6. This approval allows the safety vessel to travel within the defined area as per Map 1 of the Navigation Safety Bylaw 2016, and to transit to and from the Corsair bay beach and coastline.

Temporary Reservation shall not take effect if: Conditions above are not met.
