

INDIVIDUAL MOORING INSPECTOR/CONSTRUCTOR

The Harbourmaster requires all inspectors to apply for authorisation to inspect their own/others' moorings in order to assess if they are competent to carry out an inspection and repair of a mooring.

The details the Harbourmaster requires on an inspector and mooring inspection are as follows:

- Documentation/statements to demonstrate the inspector's qualifications (diving, engineering qualifications) and/or experience in inspecting mooring systems;
- The methodology on how the mooring inspection will be carried out and how the inspector will measure the componentry on the mooring system.
- Recording the details; how will the details will be recorded (photographs of block/block ring/componentry).

Please complete <u>HAROO3</u> to apply for authorisation to inspect a mooring system.
