- 3. First Aid kit to be onsite.
- 4. Any wake to be kept to the minimum possible.
- 5. Any vessel responding an emergency, the skipper is required to provide a report to the Harbourmaster within 48 hours of the incident, outlining details of incident, and names and addresses of people involved.
