# **MEMORANDUM**

**SUBJECT:** Recommended changes to the Canterbury freshwater plans pursuant to

Clause 20A of Schedule 1 to the Resource Management Act 1991

(RMA)

The National Policy Statement for Freshwater Management 2020 (NPSFM 2020) directs Councils to 'give effect' to its provisions 'as soon as reasonably practicable' and to notify freshwater plans that give effect to the NPSFM 2020 by 31 December 2024.

Regional councils are directed to incorporate clauses 3.22(1), 3.24(1) and 3.26(1) of the NPSFM 2020, or words to the same effect, into relevant regional plans.

The incorporation of provisions from a national policy statement into regional plans requires Council approval<sup>1</sup>. At a Council meeting on 24 September 2020, Council resolved to incorporate clauses 3.22(1), 3.24(1) and 3.26(1) into relevant regional plans. A copy of the Council resolution is attached as Appendix 1.

Consequential changes to regional plans are now required. These changes include renumbering and relocating existing plan provisions and other minor changes (e.g. changes to the table of contents of each plan).

The authority to correct minor errors in a plan is provided for through Clause 20A of Schedule 1 to the RMA. Clause 20A of Schedule 1 to the RMA states:

"A local authority may amend, without using the process in this schedule, an operative policy statement or plan to correct any minor errors"

In addition, Part 4.3(3) of the NPSFM 2020 states:

"If a local authority chooses to amend an operative policy statement or plan by merely changing wording or terminology for consistency with this National Policy Statement, the amendment is to be treated as the correction of a minor error (and therefore, under clause 20A of Schedule 1 of the Act, the amendment can be made without using a process in that Schedule)."

Table 1 below sets out corrections to regional plans that are required as a consequence of incorporating clauses 3.22(1), 3.24(1) and 3.26(1) of the NPSFM 2020.

It is considered appropriate to use Clause 20A to Schedule 1 to the RMA to amend the Canterbury freshwater plans for the following reasons:

- The authority for the change is provided in Part 4.3 of the NPSFM 2020.
- The recommended changes arise as a consequence of changes directed by the National Policy Statement for Freshwater Management 2020.
- The changes do not change the outcomes or policy intent.

## Recommendation

I recommend the above changes are approved under Clause 20A of Schedule 1 to the RMA as 'corrections of a minor effect', and a copy of the changes displayed on the Environment Canterbury Website.

  - 1.1 include clause 3.26(1) of the National Policy Statement for Freshwater Management 2020 as a new objective (where relevant)
  - 1.2 included clauses 3.22(1) and 3.24(1) of the National Policy Statement for Freshwater Management 2020 as new policies.
- 2. Notes that if these amendments are approved, public notification of the changes will occur within five working days of the changes being made.
