Notices of this Temporary Reservation shall be displayed where they may best be seen by river users at the following locations from Monday 10th January 2022, and removed the day following the event: At the Mt White Bridge kayak put-in; Alongside the access road into the Woodstock launching area; At the access route to the river at the Waimakariri Gorge Bridge; At the launching ramp on the Waimakariri River immediately upstream of the SH1 bridges; At any other locations routinely used for launching of powered or non-powered vessels.

Commercial Jet Boat Operators are to be contacted two weeks prior to the event and be provided with a copy of the safety plan, timings and contact details of event organisers.

A copy of the Temporary Reservation Certificate shall be carried by marshals and other event staff who are able to advise other river users of the reservation.

Safety conditions:

Those in support and safety vessels are to wear suitable PFDs at all times, and the vessels are to be appropriately equipped for their safety role.

All competitors are required to wear PFDs

The safety plan is to be complied with and all competitors briefed as to the risks and hazards on the Waimakariri River

The Holder of this Temporary Reservation Certificate shall undertake all reasonably practicable precautions to ensure the health and safety of all persons involved in the race.

The Waimakariri River between Mount White Bridge and the Waimakariri Gorge is to be surveyed prior to the event and any hazards to be noted and competitors and safety vessels advised of said hazards.

Temporary Reservation shall not take effect if: Conditions above are not met.
